RHYME TIME

Choose a common word. Have your child try to come up with words that RHYME with the word you give them. These can be REAL words or NON-SENSE words. See how many rhymes you can come up with. This is a fun activity to do as you drive in the car or are waiting in a line.

RHYME Starters:

MYSTERY WORD

Have your child help set the dinner table by asking them to get items for the table. Stretch a word out by sounds. Ask them to get 5 "CCCCC- UUUU- PPPP- SSS" and hopefully they will get 5 cups. Do this for articles of clothing, toys, foods, etc.

LETTERS LETTERS EVERYWHERE

Write the letters of the alphabet on pieces of paper and play "HIDE & SEEK" for the letters. Students can search for a specific letter that you tell them to, OR they can find letters and SHOUT out the letters as they find them. Change the game and use only UPPER CASE letters or LOWER CASE letters OR do a mix UPPER and LOWER case letters. Look for letters as you are out and about!

2. Does this book remind you of another book we've read?
3. Were there any parts that surprised you?
4. What should we read NEXT?
